
1. Affirmative form.

* Note: We use present perfect to talk about past situations that started in the past but have consequences in the present, they usually refer to uncommon situations.

III. Interrogative form

as seen on the examples we use verb Have or Has as an auxiliary and the verb should be always in past participle.

- (?) **Have** you **done** your homework?
- (?) **Have** they **cooked** before?
- (?) **Has** he **played** an instrument in his life?
- (?) **Has** she **eaten** all of that?



****Note:** when we ask something in present perfect, we change the order of the sentence; first the verb "to be" and then the subject, but, we usually don't ask "have I done something?"

*Remember that the WH question words such as Why, or Where, goes before the auxiliary.
