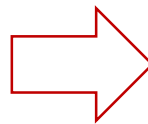
Examples:

I am in Santiago today. Yesterday, I was in Valparaíso.
 Estoy en Santiago hoy. Ayer, estaba en Valparaíso.

My friends are in Valparaíso today. Yesterday, they were in Santiago.
 Mis amigos están en Valparaíso hoy. Ayer, ellos estaban en Santiago.

Was (past)

I **was** a kid. (Before)
 Kate **was not** here yesterday. (Before)
Was Kate here yesterday? (Before)

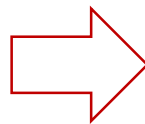


Am/is (Present)

I **am** an adult. (Now)
 Kate **is not** here. (Now)
Is Kate here? (Now)

Were (past) Are (Present)

You **were** late yesterday. (Before)
 They **were not** here last Sunday. (Before)
Were you at home yesterday? (Before)



You **are** late. (Now)
 They **are not** here. (Now)
Are you at home? (Now)
